You have attained the respect and admiration of your peers by distinguishing yourself in service and leadership to your unit and you have been rewarded with this remarkable opportunity. If you so choose to take the path that has been laid before you, a world of new opportunities for brotherhood, leadership, and service will open before you, as they have for so many that have come before.

In 1915, two men, Dr. E. Urner Goodman and Carol A. Edson, started what would become an international program within the Boy Scouts. From the Treasure Island scout camp, in Pennsylvania, they established the principles of Brotherhood, Cheerfulness, and Service then applied them to a group of young men who were found willing to spend themselves in serving others. When camp ended, these young men were bound together and in so doing, became the first members of the Order of the Arrow. Since that time, the program has spread coast to coast and across two oceans.

As with any journey, it begins with a single step, the first step. That first step is the Induction. It is for you to decide whether or not you will go forth upon this journey, but it is my sincerest wish that I might call you a brother after your choice has been made.

Induction Information

If you choose to take the path laid before you, then you must first complete the Induction.

Where: Boxwell Scout Reservation

When: August 4-6, 2017

How much: Early Fee - \$61.00 (by July 25) or regular Fee - \$71.00 (after July 25)

What to bring: There are several key elements that you must bring to the Induction.

(Keep in mind that **all** items must fit in a backpack)

| • Work clothes you don't mind getting dirty | A pair of work gloves |
| • Rain gear | A full stomach on Friday night. |
| • Cash for use in the trading post | A good Scouting attitude |

A tent or hammock for Saturday night

Things not permitted:

- Any food or drinks, radios, TVs, sheath knives, hunting knives, MP3 players, computer games
- Garbage bags and totes for carrying your gear

Candidates will not be able to use cell phones during the Induction, and they are encouraged not to carry them during the event due to the possibility of breaking or losing them during the activities.

If a candidate needs a phone due to an emergency, a phone will be available to use.

Registration Information

Registration begins registering online at www.wa-hi-nasa.org or mailing in the attached registration form to the Council Service Center. On Site check-in starts at the Stahlman Dining Hall at 5pm and goes until 7:00 p.m. on Friday night. Those who arrive after 7:30 p.m. will **not** be able to go through the Induction because you will have missed key aspects of the weekend and it would be unfair to you if you were to miss them. The weekend will end at 10am on Sunday morning.
